The board is well represented in terms of regional representation and gender balance. In new term there is a new member for Early career research.

#### 3. Activities

• **ESA conference Athens, 2017**. RN22 sessions:

The Research Network RN22 "Sociology of Risk and Uncertainty" at the ESA 2017 conference has organized 9 sessions with 38 presentations. Topics discussed included theoretical and methodological advancements in risk and uncertainty research; risk research related to inequalities, health and social care, media representations and discourses. The Network has also organized a joint session with RN12 Environment and Society on research trends in environmental risk perception. The participants represented a broad range of countries (e.g. Sweden, Italy, Germany, Russia, Poland, Netherlands, Lithuania, Finland, UK, and else). Also the sessions included presentation from scholars at different career stages.

- Mid-term. In 2016, the mid-term conference of RN22 was going to be held in Turkey, however due to the uncertain political situation it had to be cancelled.
- Newsletter. RN22 has quarterly newsletter, that presents new publications, forthcoming conferences, networking opportunities, reports about RN22 activities and else. From 2017, Newsletter is prepared together with thematic group (TG04) Sociology of Risk and Uncertainty, International Sociological Association (ISA). The newsletter is distributed through the mailing list of ESA RN22, and also other professional networks. The joining for the efforts of two networks seems efficient in terms of efforts and dissemination.
- **Social media**. Network is active in social media (twitter <a href="https://twitter.com/riskuncertainty">https://twitter.com/riskuncertainty</a> and also ESA and ISA Sociology of Risk and uncertainty are presented in webpage

http://www.riskanduncertainty.net/. The network is planning to use more of the possibilities provided by renewed ESA webpage for dissemination purposes.

• Cooperation with other professional networks. The members of ESA RN22 are actively involved in the activities of ISA TG04, so the European and International networks of sociology of risk and uncertainty closely cooperate. Significant part of members are also involved with Society for Risk Analysis (International, Europe and Nordic Chapter), that opens up the possibilities for interdisciplinary audiences in risk research. From the thematic perspective, RN22 cooperates with networks of Environment and Society, Sociology of Professions, theory and methods networks and others. RN22 with RN12 submitted application for Semi-Plenary Session at Athens conference, and also organized joined session.

# Publications, workshops.

- -During the reported period, following book was published, as an output from earlier Mid-term conference: Brown, P. and Oloffson, A. (eds.) (2016) Risk, Uncertainty and Policy. London: Routledge.
- Based on the professional networking within RN22 of ESA, KTU with partners from 5 universities had Erasmus+ project "Risk and Security Governance in Nordic Baltic Countries" (2016-2018). Final conference "Risks for Regions and Regions at Risk" was organized in Vilnius, prof. Anna Olofsson was one of plenary speakers.
- -Network members organized workshop *Researching Risk and Uncertainty Methodologies, Methods and Research Strategies*. November 29-December 1. 2016, Ostersund, Sweden. The contributions will be peer reviewed and published in an edited book on methodologies, methods and research strategies within the book series *Critical Studies in Risk and Uncertainty* with Palgrave Macmillan (series editors are Patrick Brown, Anna Olofsson and Jens O. Zinn).

## Future activities

In 2018, Mid-term conference of RN22 "Complexities of risk and uncertainty" is going to be organized at Kaunas university of Technology, Lithuania, 4-5 October. Pre-conference PhD workshop will be organized in order to attract PhD students to the network and help them to improve their work in risk sociology. There will be a financial support for the best students to attend the workshop.

In coming term, RN also will focus more on publishing opportunities for papers from Mid-term conferences and sessions at ESA conferences.
